PRIME The necklace featured above is a lariat....one long strand of colourful and contrasting beads with sterling silver pieces at each end. Wear it long, wrap it around, tie it in knot. Adapt it to the shape you want. The earrings and rings are also PRIME. Each piece has eleven sides; six on the outside and five on the inside. Just a little math fun!

FACTS ABOUT SILVER

- Silver was discovered about 4000 BC.
- In the earliest Egyptian records, silver was considered more precious than gold.
- By the 1700s, Spaniards developed mines in Mexico, Bolivia, Peru.
- 60% of silver is used in photography.
- Silver is used for water purification, because it prevents bacteria growth. It's a great alternative to powerful chemicals, such as chlorine and bromine.
